


## **BUG HUNT**

When you are out in the park look out for bugs in grass, plants and trees.


You can also turn over wood and rocks. Tick the box when you find a bug. Be gentle with the animals, don't leave them in the sun and return them to






When you are out in the park look out for these animal houses. Tick the box when you find the house. Can you say who lives in each house? There might be more than one animal! Be careful not to disturb them.






When you are out in the park look out for different types of plants. Tick the box when you find one. Don't pick the plants, leave them for other people to enjoy.





When you are out in the park look out for different types of trees and see if you can identify them from their leaves. Tick the box if you find a leaf. Can you find any other leaf shapes? In autumn look for the fruits and berries that grow on the trees but be careful not to eat them.






## **ALPHABET HUNT**

When you are out in the park look for things or objects whose name begins with different letters of the alphabet. An example for the letter "C" might be CLOUDS or CHILDREN. Write the name of the object in the space. You can make it more difficult by including describing words "colourful clouds", "cheerful children". Can you find any other objects or things that begin with other letters?





When you are out in the park look for things or objects whose shape is similar to the shapes that we have drawn. Write the name of your object in the shape or draw a picture of what you have found. Can you find any other objects or things that have different shapes?
