Awareness of signposting



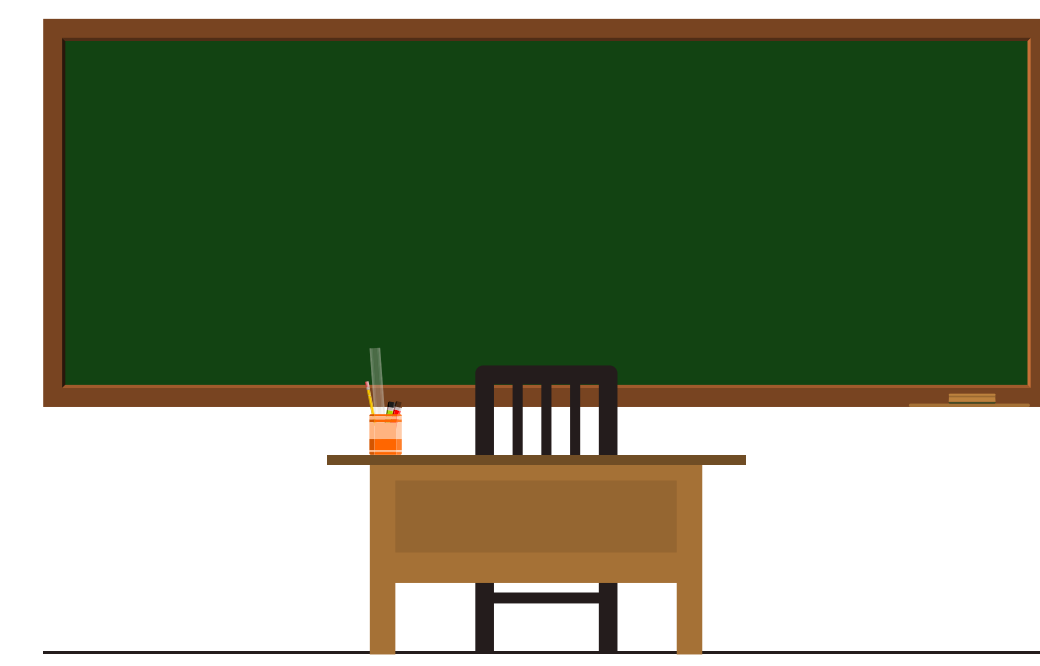
### Clear Communications about resources and services
