

The spirit of Eel Pie Island and the working riverside will extend up Water Lane to King Street past new boathouses and through a new Market Place.




GROUND FLOOR PLAN











Water Lane building

A mix of retail, restaurants, cafés, artists studios, office space and new homes will bring a vibrancy and life to the Riverside.



Arcadian Overlook


The Overlook is designed as a promontory to look over the Riverside and take in the arcadian views towards Richmond Hill to the east and across to the curve of the River at Radnor Gardens to the west.

Riverside terrace The Riverside Terraces are where Twickenham most literally connects with the Thames. Extending down to the water, the terraces are designed as a place to come together, facing out to Eel Pie Island. Boaters can arrive here, land their vessels, and make their way on foot to the cafés. The Terraces are designed to flood every day as the Thames rises and falls There are over 500m2 of marginal riparian planting which will greatly increase the habitat and bio-diversity of the river front.

Eet Pie Yard Eet Pie Yard is the front door to Eet Pie Island. It is a functional with upper and lower spaces tinked by steps. It is bounded by cafés, and the Market Hatt Community Centre. The lower space designed for service and vehicle access and turning. A pavili shelter, anchors the space, and acts as a beacon drawing pe
