# FUNDING UPDATE

- LIP funding on hold
- Council-own funding is currently being utilised to progress priority projects
- Capital Programme has been updated for 2022/23 to include major funding for:
  - Hospital Bridge Road
  - Hampton Court Road
  - Strawberry Vale
  - Meadway zebra crossing
  - Broad Lane (Hampton) zebra crossing
  - 20 MPH Phase 2 Schemes (Petersham Rd, London Rd, Park Rd Hampton Hill, Warren Rd/Nelson Rd Whitton)
  - School Streets ANPR enforcement

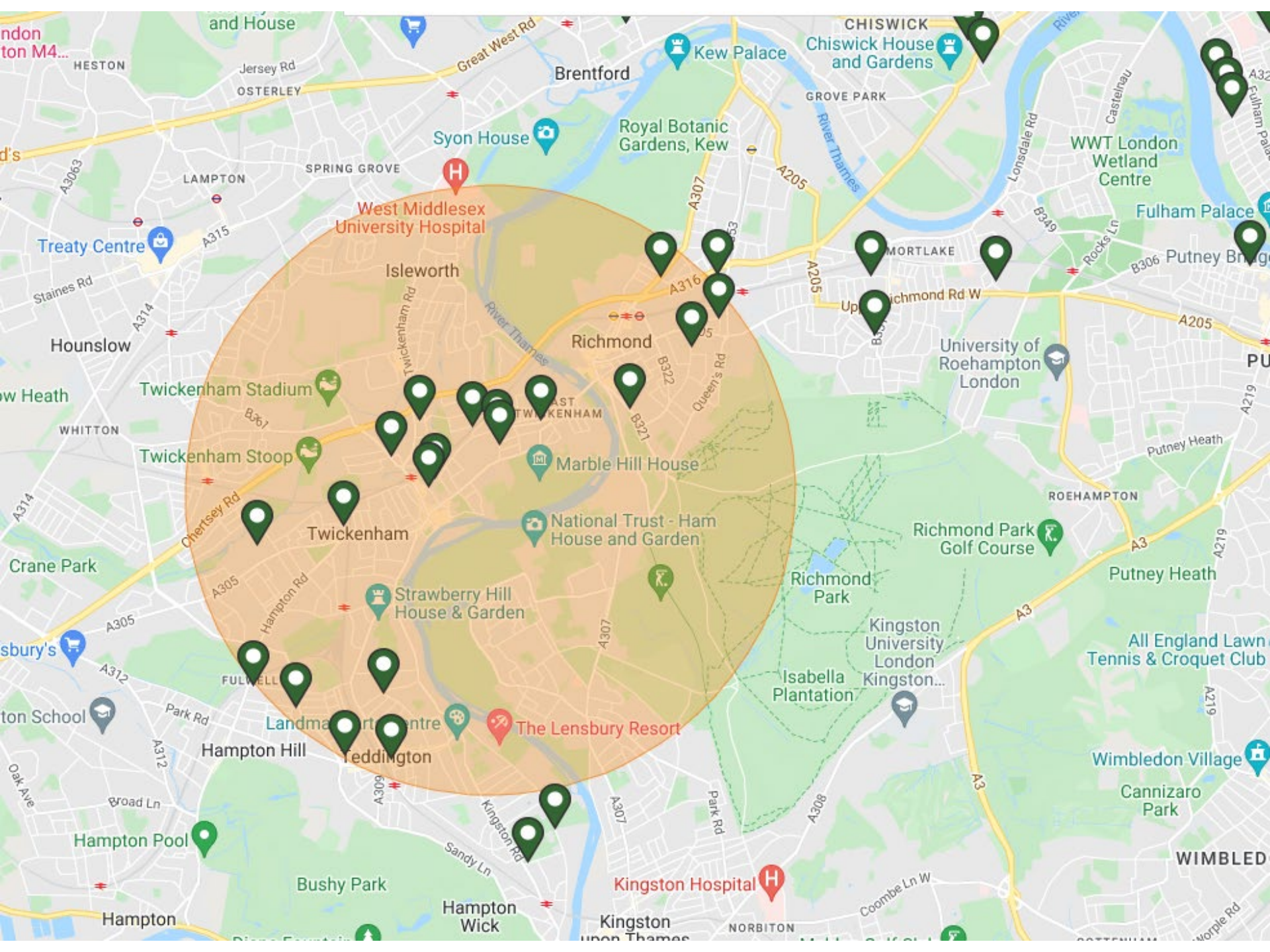

# BIKE HANGARS

- 712 online requests
- 25 bikehangars currently on street, 5 on estates
  - 24 are fully occupied
  - 3 spaces available in Broom Road, Teddington
  - 3 more to be installed on street
  - 5 more to be installed on estates
- Around £150,000 of further funding allocated for additional locations
  - Will cover 40-50 new bikehangars

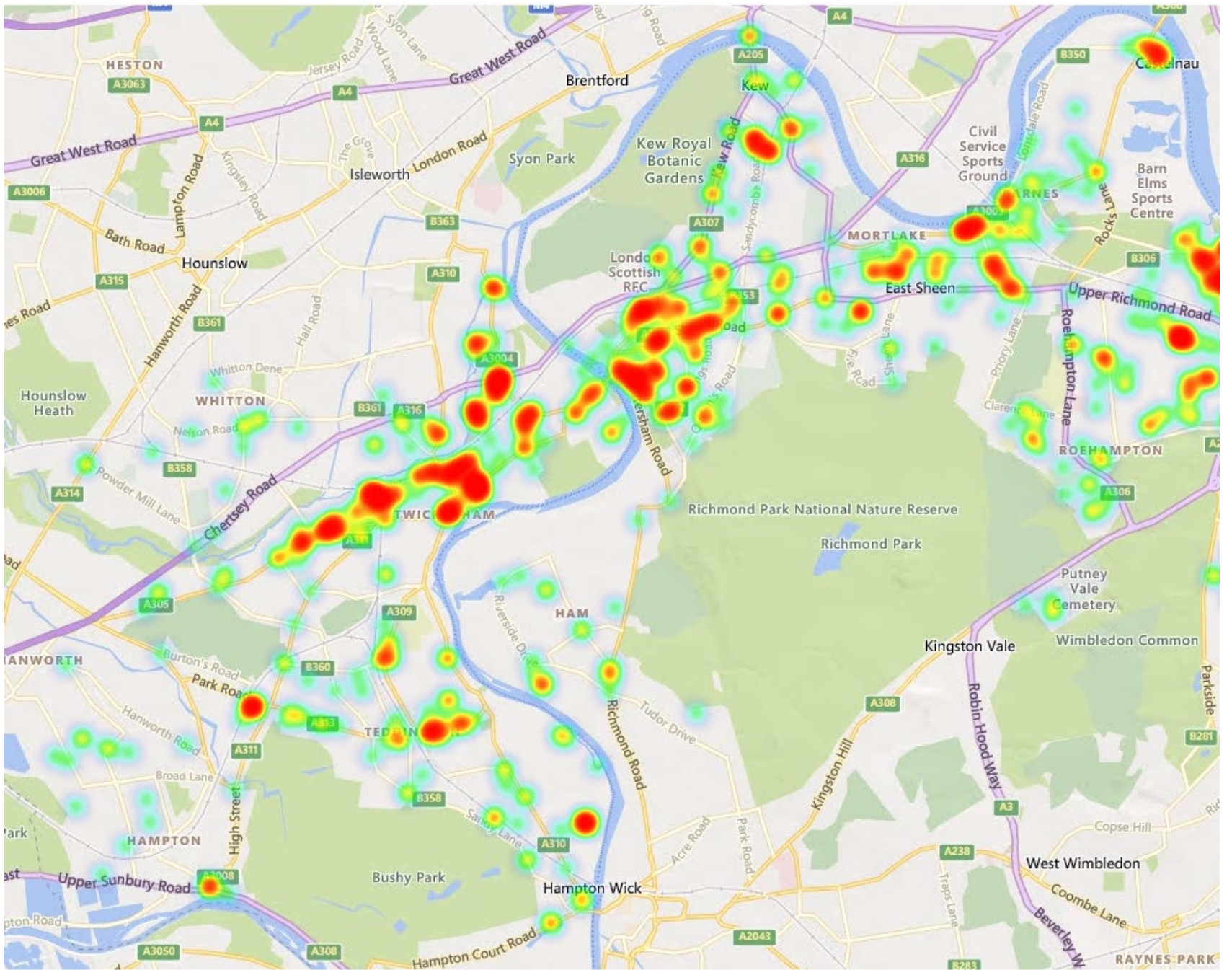

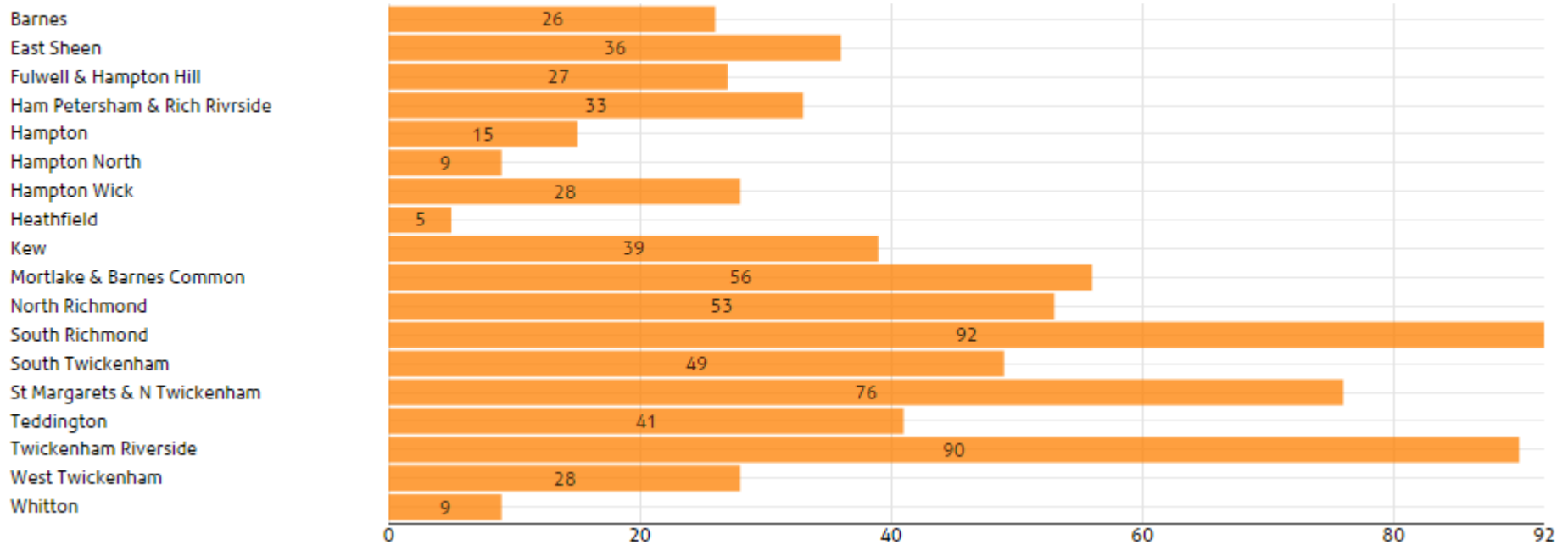

▼ Bikehangar - LBR Ward (01/03/2022 11:17:24)



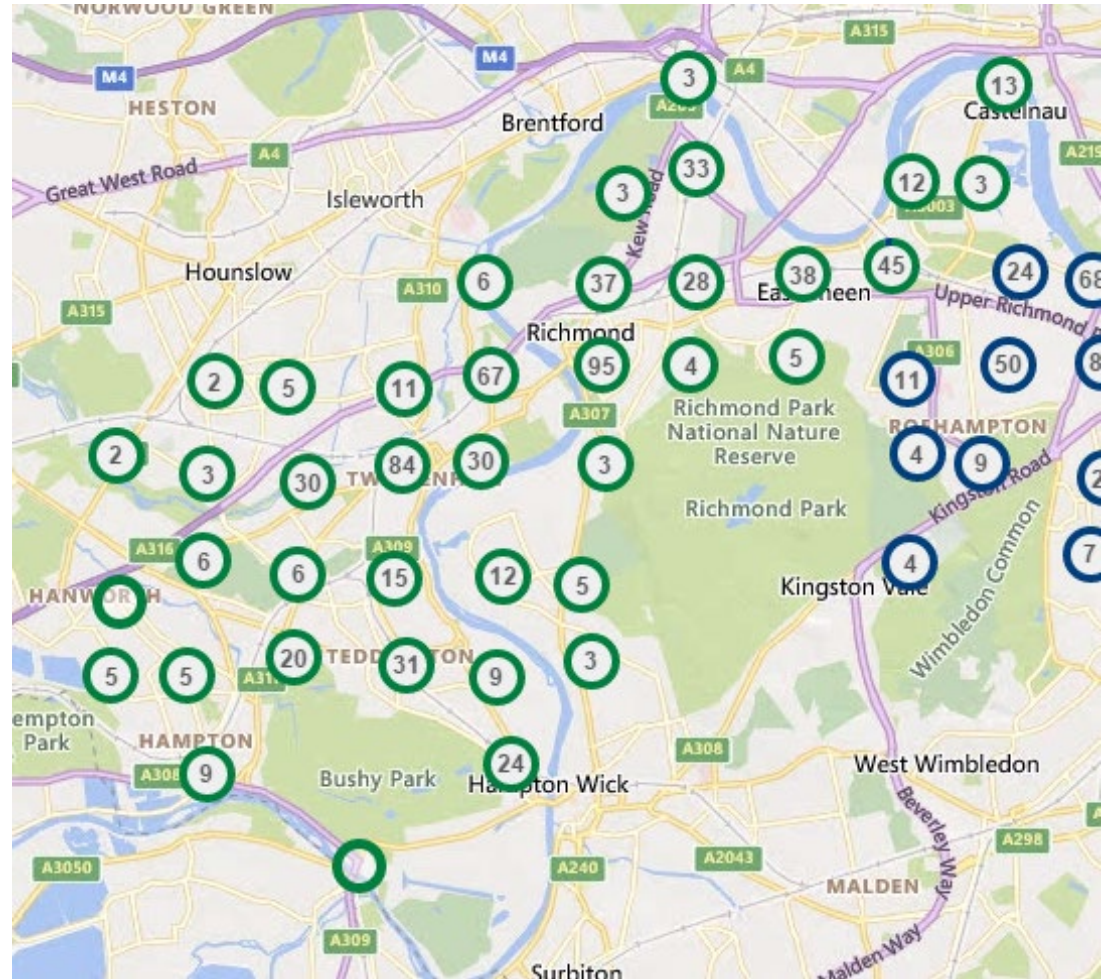
# PHASE 3

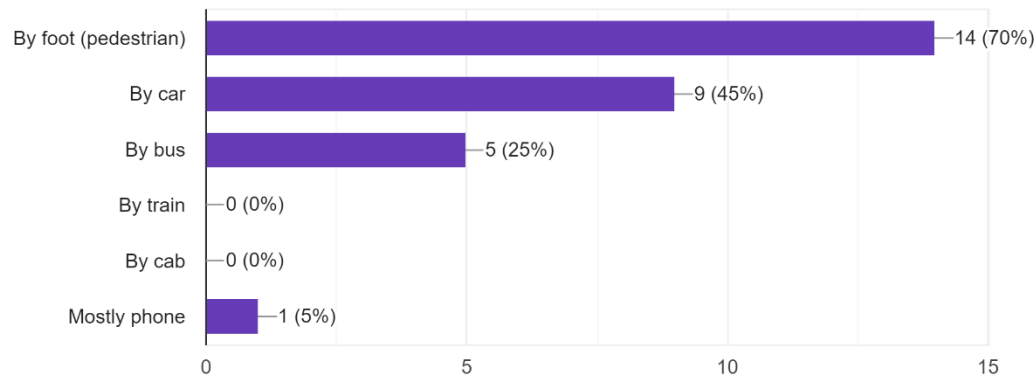

- Business engagement team have spoken to 20 of the businesses to gather information on their operations and their hopes for the refurbishment

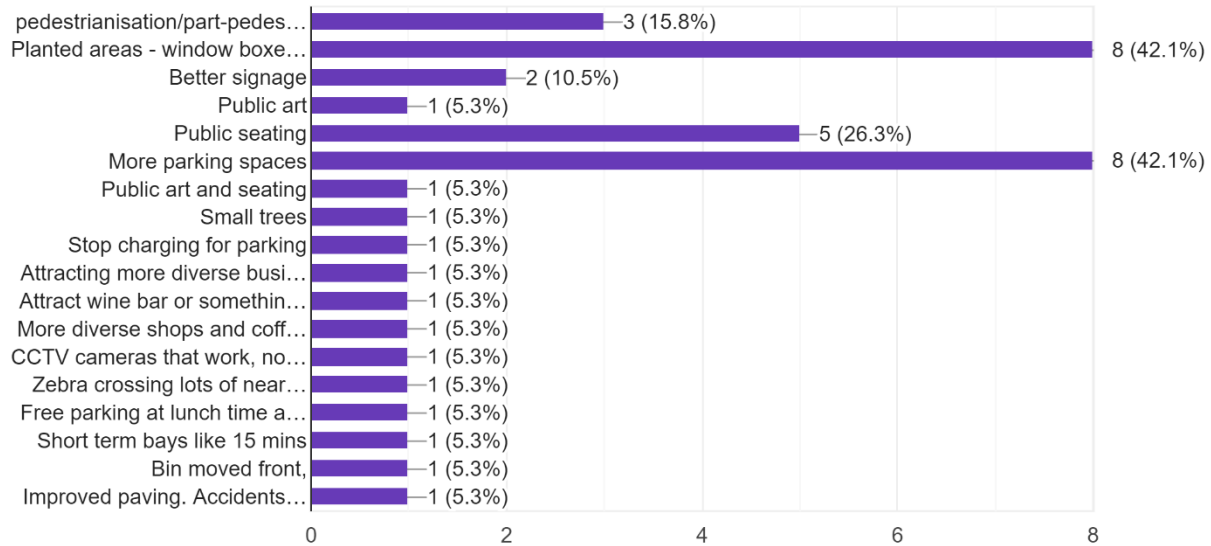
How do you think most of your customers travel to Ham Parade?

# HAM PARADE

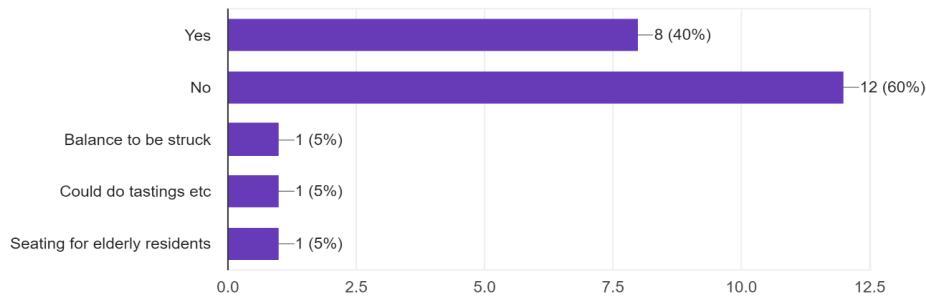
What would you most like to see as part of a refurbishment?

Would your business benefit from having more outside space for seating, displays, etc?

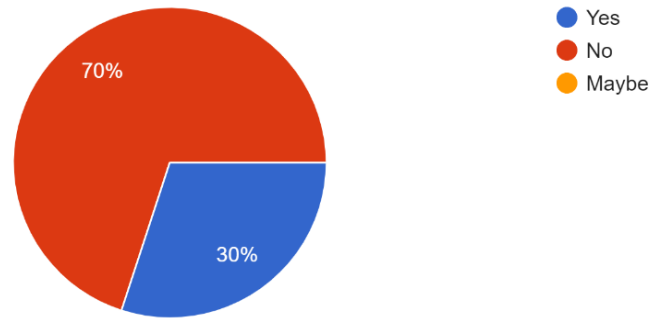
20 responses

# HAM PARADE

How can we minimise parking impact while also repurposing space to improve public realm?

- Working with colleagues in Highways to understand parking numbers under various layout options
- Desire is still to remove the access road, but will need to consider other options as well as we need to ensure we have support of the businesses

Will continue to look at design options with aim for consultation in May/June
