

Extension to a Deed of Grant

The Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial is issued for a set period. From the 1940s this was for a period of 50 years. The Deed will state when the Rights were issued and for how long.

A Registered Owner can apply to the Cemeteries Office at any time to extend the Deed, as 100 years can be held at any one time.

To extend the Rights to a grave, the Registered Owner can fill in and return this form to the Cemetery Office, with the original Deed and appropriate fee. The Deed will be endorsed and returned to you.

The fee payable is for each 5 year period required. Payment can be made by debit card, by cheque (payable to L.B.R.U.T), in cash, or by credit card, which is subject to a handling fee.

Once the Rights have expired, the ownership reverts to the Burial Authority / Council. If the Rights to the grave have expired, you can still apply to re-purchase the grave. Please contact the cemetery office for a re-purchase application form.
